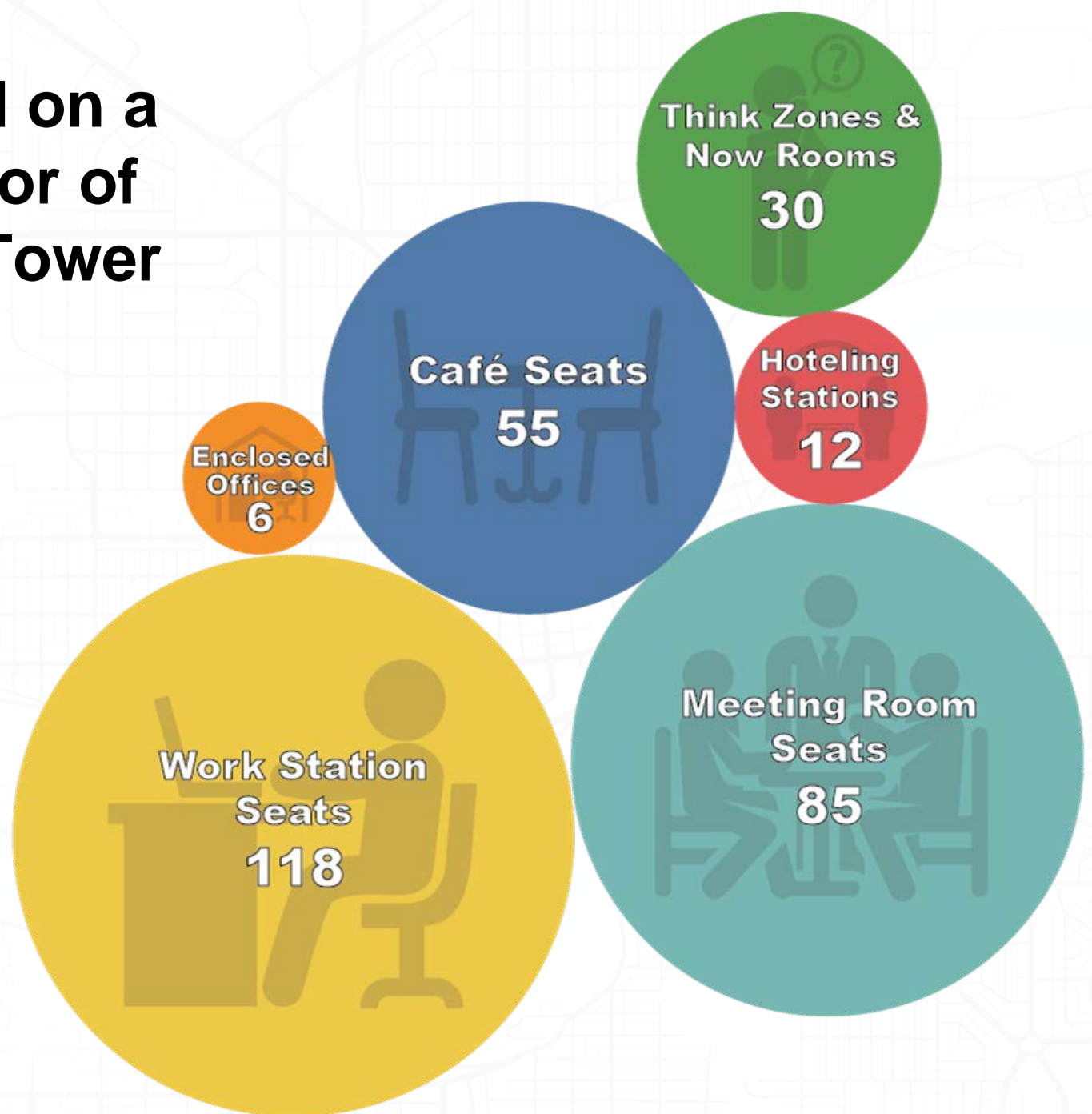

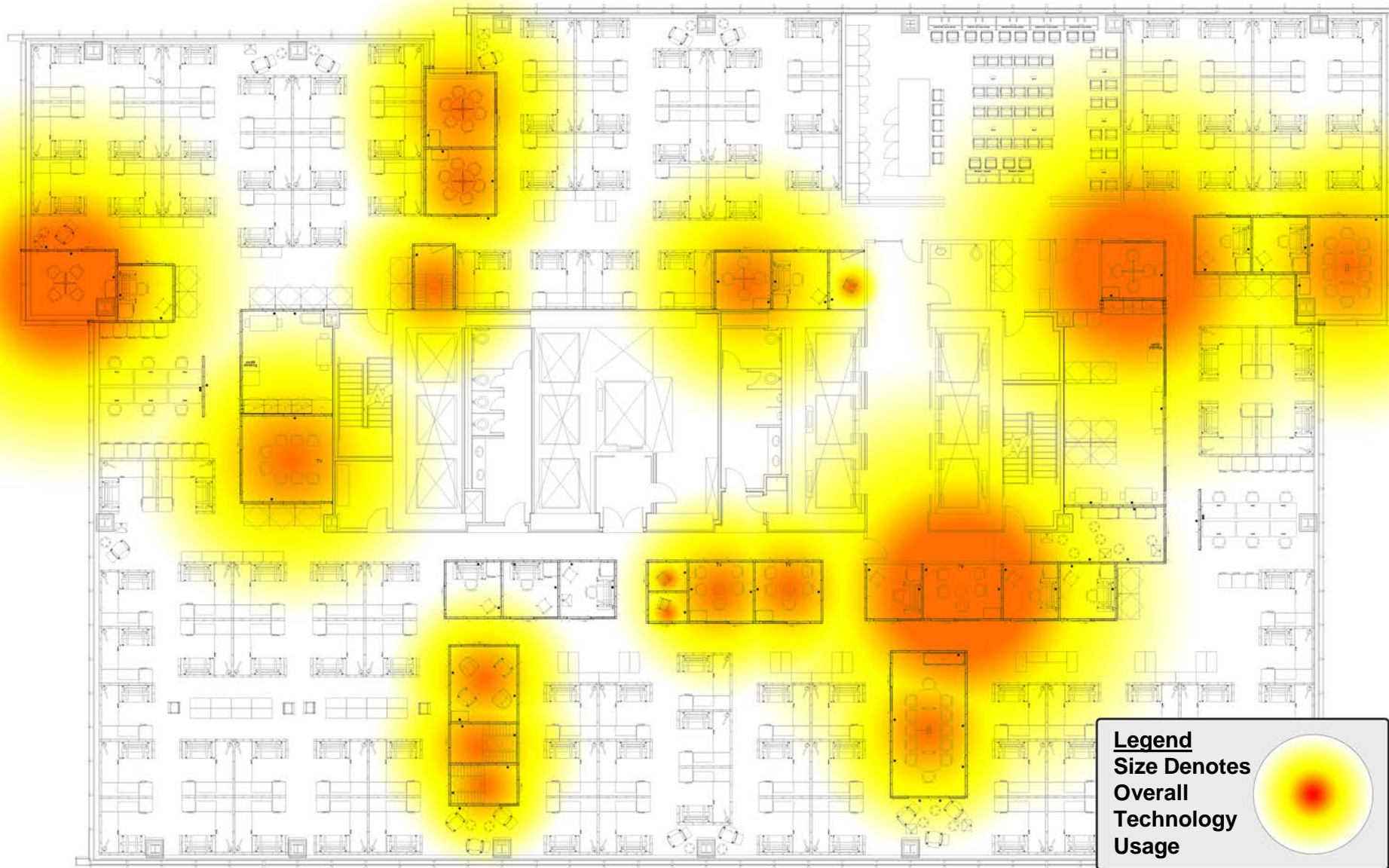




Seats found on a Typical Floor of Edmonton Tower
